#### **KEEP IN STEP WITH THE SPIRIT**



As we continue our sermon series about the work of the Holy Spirit, I thought it might be helpful to reflect this week on the Apostle Paul's words in Galatians 5:25 "Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit".

I was reminded that if we try to run ahead of the Holy Spirit, we are likely to make decisions in our own strength or take a wrong path. We can easily lose touch.

If we lag behind we cannot clearly hear a voice and can easily get lost!

When we keep in step, we can build a friendship, get closer and be guided along the right path. So it is for our relationship with God if we walk in step with the Holy Spirit.

As we heard last Sunday, the Holy Spirit reveals Jesus to us and when we repent and commit our lives to Jesus Christ, He comes to live in us and longs to fill us daily with His presence and guide us each day.

#### Let us pray this week:-

- That our relationship with Jesus through His Holy Spirit will grow deeper day by day.
- That as individuals and as a church we will allow God to grow His fruit in us and use the gifts He has given us.
- That the Holy Spirit will guide the Minister of His choice to contact us and we will be guided by the Holy Spirit to discern God's choice for us.
