Through the Scriptures lives can be changed –

that is why having the Bible in your own language can be so powerful. So Will was planning to travel to the Central African Republic for three weeks in May to work with the new Gbagiri translators (who he worked with in November last year) checking more of their translation of Luke's Gospel. He was also going to spend some time face to face with the Nzakara translators, helping them to prepare their New Testament for typesetting,

hopefully by the end of this year. However, last minute changes in the visa process mean that this trip has had to be cancelled.

His colleague Eva, who still plans to go, will be delivering further training for 20+ new translators now working in eight different languages, helping them to learn how to correctly work out the meaning of the Bible passages that they will be translating. Now she'll have to do this on her own.

Please pray:-

- That Will's trip can be rescheduled and that he can use the extra time in the UK wisely.
- For Will's work with the Nzakara team. Give thanks that they are getting close to typesetting, so that in the near future more people will have access to the New Testament in their own heart language!
- For a good internet connection in Bangui to help Will (and others) work remotely with the teams there.
- That the new translators will learn well and be better equipped after their training to do the job to which God has called them.
- For Judith as she takes time to process the loss of her father and catches up on work which has piled up because of recent events.
