UPDATE FROM PRAYER MEETING

Our focus this time was on being a church that encourages and builds up its people. We read Eph.ch 4 v 1-16, and Col. ch 3 v12-17 and used these as our guide to prayer.

We remembered that 'church' should be a supportive environment for Christians to gather for worship and prayer, and to encourage and care for each other.

It is also a place where we all use our Godgiven spiritual gifts to build up the body of Christ for works of service.

We prayed for those who lead and preach, those who read the scriptures, teach the children, operate the sound and vision equipment, those on the Prayer Team, those who prepare and serve communion or lead the music and singing. There are those who clean and set up for each Sunday, lead and help with groups during the week, in church or in home groups, those who bring folk to church week by week, or visit those who are unable to attend or not well.

We are all precious and part of God's family here.

The challenge is-are you encouraging others as much as you could? Are you fully using your God given gifts in His service? Do spend some time seeking God if you are not sure of your gift. Ask Him what you could say or do this week to encourage someone in church. And be blessed.
