UPDATE FROM PRAYER MEETING

Proverbs ch.3 v 5-6. We considered this very well-known proverb and thought about how much do we really trust in God, is it with ALL our heart?

Do we acknowledge Him in ALL our ways, our thoughts, our speech, our behaviour, in all situations, in all our problems, in every season?

We humans are always wanting to be in control of every part of our lives, (which has been the problem since the beginning!)

but as Christians, we must learn to let go so that God will really be in control of our lives. Consider Moses, the reluctant hero, who learned to listen and follow God's plan for him. Consider Joshua, who followed God and led the Israelites into the Promised Land. Consider Jehoshaphat, who when faced with a mighty enemy simply prayed, 'O God, we do not know what to do, but our eyes are on You.'

We might make plans, for ourselves or for our church, but we need to listen to God, for He might have different plans. But His plans, His timing and His purposes are perfect, for He sees, He knows and He understands all things.

We prayed for all the events happening over the Christmas period, for the future of WBC and for us all, that we will listen, trust and be obedient to all that our wonderful God has in store for us. May we all continue to pray the same, remembering that His plans for us are only good, because of His great love for us.

OUR CHRISTMAS PROJECT

This Christmas we will be supporting **Tearfund's Christmas Appeal for Central African Republic**. The Central African Republic (CAR) ranks among the most impoverished nations globally. It has suffered from decades of conflict and instability, which has severely hindered its development. Will and Judith Sawers, missionaries from our church, who have lived there, can testify to the poverty which is to be seen all around. They work with Wycliffe Bible translators, to provide the Scriptures to people groups in their own languages and have seen how Christians, living according to those Scriptures, can make a real difference in their communities.



The lady in the photo is Melanie, who lives in Bangui (CAR). When she first got married, her husband had no work. In a country where approximately 70 per cent of the population lives in extreme poverty, Melanie has experienced firsthand the distress of not having enough for her basic needs. 'I know how seeing your child hungry feels. I know what it is to feel helpless. I gave my suffering to God, and He made a path,' she says. These experiences gave her a deep longing to help other women escape poverty.

About 75 per cent of women in CAR lack access to education, denying them many of the opportunities they need to earn an income. This often means they then can't afford to send their children to school either. It's a vicious cycle, keeping whole families trapped in situations of extreme poverty.

So, Melanie became involved in Tearfund's Communities training course which uses biblical concepts to help people identify practical solutions to the problems they, their families and their communities are facing. She learnt how to read and write and through this training course she and her friend Esther brought together a group of women, who are learning practical skills to help them improve their own earning opportunities. 'When someone has an issue, we talk, pray, and read the Bible to find insights that help us make good decisions and improve our lives,' she says. The training and support of Tearfund has enabled them not only to escape dire poverty, but also to help others in the same way.



Now Melanie, who has 7 children and a number of grandchildren, supports her family through her small business selling various goods. Her husband takes on available jobs and between them, over time, they have managed to buy land and build a home. She thanks God for giving them a hope and a future.

The money we give this Christmas will enable more women to get involved in the Tearfund Communities Training programme and find freedom in Christ and a way out of poverty.



WE CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE




