LET US PRAY FOR IRAN – A STORY FROM THE BIBLE SOCIETY

Grace works on Bible translation into her native language in Iran... in fact, that's how she came to faith.

"My husband, Barad became involved in Bible translation, but it was top secret. He was worried I might accidentally betray the work to the authorities, so didn't tell me about it and wouldn't let me into the room they worked in.

"I sat by the closed door, crying because I was excluded but listening hard. **The first time I heard the name of Jesus, my soul became calm and filled with joy!**

I sat outside the door every day, listening to the Bible passages. When I heard them struggling to find the right word for the translation, I would shout it through the door. Finally, the team leader said, 'Just let her in. She needs to be part of this.'

While helping to translate, I kept hearing that Jesus Christ is love, that he is purity, that he loves the sinner, and he takes away sins. This was new to me, and I wanted it! I always wanted to get clean from the inside out, but I didn't know how.

Now I follow Jesus, and I talk about it to whoever God leads me to. In one year, I told my story to more than 600 people, and 80 of them now follow Jesus too."

Grace and Barad's names have been changed for their protection.

Please pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ in Iran. They face persecution – sometimes even death. This story is one of many coming from Iran. People are seeing visions of Christ and others are courageously sharing their faith in creative ways. They value our prayers.
