Update from Prayer Meeting

Our focus was Psalm 27 v 14 'Wait for the Lord, be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord.'

We gave thanks and praise for God's faithfulness to us, for new families and children joining WBC, for stability, unity and good fellowship, for inspirational teaching, for our outreach activities and

our many contacts. We prayed for God's guidance for the future.

We can find waiting, at times, difficult. But when we wait for the Lord, it is not empty time. We might feel we have no clear direction, then we simply need to be obedient and patient. We are changed simply in the waiting. Sometimes God gives us a clear, specific direction, sometimes more general. Sometimes He needs to prepare us for whatever lies ahead.

As we enter this new season for WBC, it is important that we take time to wait, to discern what God requires of us.

Where do we see God already at work?

What should be our priorities?

Are there new things God would want us to begin?

Are there any activities He would want us to put aside?

These are questions not only for the whole church, but also for us individually. We need to think about the gifts God has given us. Are we using them?

Please take time to pray, listen and wait for the Lord to speak. If you feel you receive any particular answer or inspiration, please speak to one of the Leadership Team.

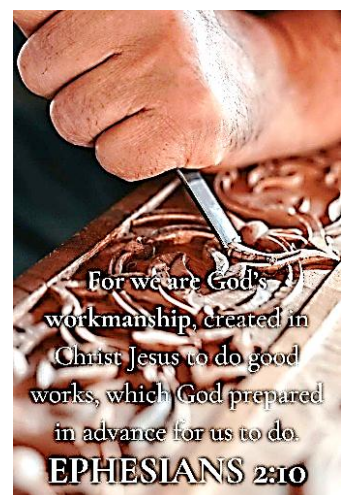
Ephesians 2 8-10 NLT
